Only 40% of the student body has submitted assessments. It is important to note the following:

- If you have access to content, lecturers and assessments then you should be submitting your assessments as soon as possible and not waiting for the completion date.
- Textbook summaries for semester 1; You can find them on the student portal in a zipped folder, per qualification.
- You can improve your results by submitting a first draft, receiving feedback and then resubmitting your assessments. You can only benefit from this if you submit earlier.
- Semester 2 commences before the completion date for semester 1. Therefore you will have to focus on semester 2 modules whilst completing semester 1 assessments. You can avoid this pressure by submitting assessments before the start of semester 2.
