SEMESTER 1 SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENTS



Our country is facing unprecedented turmoil and all of us are impacted – some of us directly.

To provide some immediate relief for you as you try to finish your summative assessments for the first semester, please note that we have decided as follows:



B.Law 411 and BLAW226 and B. Acc **written timed exams completed according to the normal exam duration at home:**

1. Students who are unable to complete their exams on the date and at the time communicated, because of the current instability, should make an application on the Student Hub in terms of section 10.2.1 of the Assessment Strategy and Policy. You will be permitted to write in the supplementary period which is currently scheduled for December.
2. If you complete the exam, and are not successful, you will automatically be granted access to the supplementary exam, irrespective of your result, and the supplementary will not be capped at 50%.



Assessments with Submission Deadlines

1. If you have a submission deadline of any sort between now and Saturday 17th July and cannot submit due to being affected by the civil unrest, you may submit your work on the 19th of July, but at the time you would normally have done so as per your PAS. You do not need to make an application to do this.
2. If you do not submit on the 19th of July and this is due to the current unrest you need to make an application in terms of Section 10.2.1 of the Assessment Strategy and Policy citing the nature of the impact of the unrest and you will be permitted further concessions as follow:
 - a. If it is a take home examination, you will be permitted to write it at the supplementary assessment sitting in August or December, depending on which one applies to your module. Please follow the supplementary dates indicated on your PAS – please note it may then be an invigilated sit-down examination.
 - b. If it is another form of submission, you may be granted an extension based on the policy and the unrest in your area of residence at the time of the application.
 - c. If you cannot submit on the 19th of July for any reason not related to the civil unrest you may apply via the Student Hub for the appropriate concession.
3. Anyone who does submit now and fails, will automatically qualify for a supplementary assessment or a resubmission, that will not be capped but will have to be done on the timelines given to you.

For all deadlines and examinations after 17 July, applications are required on the Hub so that your concessions can be managed.

We hope that these concessions will give you some respite and that you and your families remain safe.
