Follow up letter in relation to the letter dated 14 April 2020 regarding language modules in the Education qualifications

I trust that you are all well and coping with the uncertain times that the Covid-19 pandemic has created in our country.

We have stipulated in previous communiques that The IIE is formulating a solution that will not negatively impact the achievement of the outcomes that develop expertise in language teaching. The following decisions have been made.

- **BEF312 and BEI 312:** The First Additional Language and Language Didactic Modules will now continue on RCLearn in the first semester as foundational knowledge has been built in these languages. These languages contain assessment changes. All relevant addendums have been uploaded to your student portal. Your online learning experience will include aspects like (but is not limited to) loaded course content, learning support resources, collaborate sessions and activities to aid your learning experience in these modules.
- **HCEC115:** The Communicative Languages for the Higher Certificate in Early Childhood Care and Education will be moved to the second semester due complexities and potential limited exposure that students may have in their chosen communicative language. We will advise students how this module will possibly be run, based on National Department announcements.

A revised assessment timetable for education qualifications has been uploaded on the student portal. Please manage your time well when doing assessments in order to meet the required assessment outcomes.

We will keep you updated with developments as they transpire and look forward to welcoming you back onto our campuses as soon as permission to do so has been granted.
