Taking the above and the students' safety and quality of education into consideration, IIERC has adopted a method of teaching that incorporates blended learning (a mixture of face-to-face and online participation) to ensure quality academic service delivery to all students during lockdown level 1. (Please refer to communications sent regarding the 2021 Teaching and Learning Model).

All IIERC campuses adhere to the strictest Covid-19 prevention protocols and through the application thereof, students can control much of their own safety while on campus.

This is achieved through:

- Regular sanitizing of venues
- Wearing of masks at all times
- Social distancing
- Restricted venue capacity

With the Teaching and Learning approach of 2021, the following is possible:

- Venue capacity is at 50%
- The total number of students on campus at any given point in time is restricted to 33% of the total number of registered students
- Timetables have incorporated breaks during which time venues are sanitized if a different group of students is expected to occupy the venue.
- Phase 2 of the 3-phase blended learning model can be completed off-campus.

We request that students attend campus as per their timetable in order to manage building capacity restrictions and to avoid compromising the safety protocols. We are together responsible for ensuring that all the safety protocols are met.
