- 1) An overall NQF Level 8 qualification average of at least 65% is normally required.
- 2) All students are required to complete a compulsory research methodology workshop.
- 3) All applicants who are eligible for admission to the Master of Commerce in Strategic Management degree are required to successfully complete and present a research proposal and obtain ethics clearance for the research for their mini dissertation.

Senate Discretionary Admissions Where candidates do not satisfy the formal admission requirements for this qualification, The IIE may consider an admission application in terms of the Qualification Completion, Credit Accumulation and Transfer, Articulation and Recognition of Prior Learning Policy (IIE010). If applicant does not meet minimum admission requirements and there is no alternative (such as completion of NQP modules) but they have relevant **Recognition of Prior** experience, the following must be requested to consider admission via RPL: 1. Certificates for all formal (Accredited Higher Education qualifications) and/or Learning (RPL) informal qualifications/modules (SLP's, Microcredentials etc). SAQA certificates must be provided for any international qualifications. 2. CV to determine whether the following are related to the qualification that the applicant is applying for: a. Formal (Accredited Higher Education qualifications) and/or informal qualifications/modules (SLP's, Microcredentials etc) b. Relevant work experience
