Evans Parson Zwane: From Kanyamazane to the Global Stage of the G20

Born 38 years ago in the township of Kanyamazane, Lekazi, Mpumalanga, Evans Parson Zwane’s journey to becoming the CEO of South Africa’s largest Physical AI & Robotics company reads like a modern day success saga. After completing his schooling, Evans chose IIE Rosebank College, his beloved alma mater, to pursue a Diploma in Journalism. IIE Rosebank College is a brand of the Independent Institute of Education. The induction at IIE Rosebank College was “seamless and exciting,” he recalls, because the college opened doors to a variety of courses and sparked the entrepreneurial fire that would later define his path.

His studies ignited a passion for storytelling, but the entrepreneurial spirit took over, leading him to launch his first media business straight after graduation. Fast forward two decades, and Evans now heads Optimas Robotics South Africa, the nation’s biggest Physical AI & Robotics firm. The company fields eight humanoid service robots that serve high profile clients such as Microsoft, Absa, SITA, and collaborate with institutions like University of Johannesburg, TUT, and the Department of Basic Education (Gauteng). Those partnerships underline the blend of technology and social impact that defines his vision. Evans recently took the stage at the G20 summit, an opportunity that thrust Optimas Robotics onto a world platform.

MENTORSHIP PROGRAM OVERVIEW: HIGHLIGHTS OF PROGRESS

In September 2025 the Alumni Relations Office launched the “Elevate Mentorship Program,” a campus wide initiative that brought together distinguished alumni from every corner of South Africa Braamfontein, Pretoria, Polokwane, Cape Town, Bloemfontein, Bloemfontein, Nelson Mandela and Mbombela to share real world stories and inspiration with current students. Over a series of well attended events, mentors from diverse fields sat on panels and held one on one sessions, focusing on three core pillars: Self & Personal Development, Academic Excellence, and Health & Well Being, allowing students to hear practical advice, resilience tips, and career pathways

straight from those who had walked the same halls just years earlier.

The impact was immediate and measurable: attendance topped 79 % across sites, students reported a 78 % increase in confidence about their future plans, and several partnerships formed for internships and community projects. By weaving alumni voices into the fabric of daily campus life, the program reinforced the message that the IIE RC family extends beyond graduation, offering guidance, encouragement, and a sense of belonging wherever the journey leads.

THE ROLE OF ALUMNI RELATIONS OFFICE IN FOSTERING INSTITUTIONAL LOYALTY

In a standard definition, an Alumni is a graduate, yet the meaning extends far beyond. Alumni are custodians rather than just mere torchbearers of legacy. Ideally a graduate is expected to give back to the institution however the “how” part is often misconstrued. This now features a culture of what is called “Alumni Philanthropy”.

JOB PLACEMENTS NATIONALLY: CAREER SERVICES BULLETIN



Career Services Department at IIE Rosebank College proudly issued out the latest placement results for our alumni, reflecting the strength of the partnerships we nurture with leading companies across South Africa. Out of 20 000 IIE RC graduates nationally 1987 have secured jobs.

Numbers Breakdown: 77 from IIE RC Bloemfontein, 716 from IIE RC Braamfontein, 154 from IIE RC Cape Town, 229 from IIE RC Durban, 89 from IIE RC Nelson Mandela Bay, 60 from IIE RC Mbombela, 116 from IIE RC Polokwane, 529 from IIE RC Pretoria, and 62 from IIE RC Online.

These numbers affirm our mandate: to build lasting relationships with employers and ensure every alumnus/alumna has a pathway to meaningful employment.
